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<p><b>Year 3 Training Outreach/Funding/Regional Exhibits (Lydia Collins led discussion by group )</b></p>	<p>Lydia Collins led a discussion of Suggestions and recommendations for NN/LM MAR Year 3 Training/Outreach, Funding &amp; Regional Exhibits aside from the State Library Associations, and Regional Medical Library Groups.</p> <p>Recommendations included:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Continue outreach to YMCA's and include YWCA's</li> <li>• Parent Teacher Organizations (NY State has an anti-bullying campaign to reach K-12 Audience)</li> <li>• NAMI – National Alliance on Mental Illness</li> <li>• State Senior Citizen Services Agencies</li> <li>• Area Agencies on Aging</li> <li>• Speak with Public Libraries to find out the local health/wellness fairs (have member libraries exhibit on behalf of NN/LM MAR)</li> <li>• State Legislators Offices – many hold public senior fairs</li> <li>• State Library Agencies to connect NN/LM MAR and Member Libraries/Organizations to other community/faith based organizations</li> <li>• Area Health Agencies</li> </ul>	<p>Consumer SAG Members will continue to send Lydia any recommendations.</p> <p>Lydia will work on contacting the various agencies/organizations and introduce NN/LM MAR and to them and discuss potential partnerships.</p>
