<b>Project:</b>	Network
<b>RML Goal:</b> Develop collaborations among Network members and other organizations to improve access to and sharing of biomedical information resources throughout the nation	
<b>Goal:</b> Manage the NN/LM Network membership program for the region	
<b>Outcome:</b> Growth in full and affiliate memberships	
<b>LM_Activity:</b> Membership: Recruit new network members and affiliates from eligible libraries in the region	
<b>Background:</b> Yrs 2-5: Identify promote, and recruit eligible Network Members (health sciences libraries, public libraries, community information resource centers) interested in providing health information using the most effective, appropriate methods	
<b>Indicator:</b> Full Network membership does not decrease in the region	
<b>Outcome:</b> Network members will be actively involved in the NN/LM infrastructure and outreach programs	
<b>LM_Activity:</b> Actively involve Network members in NN/LM infrastructure and outreach programs	
<p><b>Background:</b> Yrs 2-5: Promote opportunities for Network Members to become involved in NNLM infrastructure, outreach programs, working groups, and assessment of NN/LM MCR and NLM services. These areas may include but not limited to: 1)work groups, advisory groups, or task forces 2) Participation in the assessment or provision of feedback on NN/LM or NLM services such as surveys, focus groups, and other formal data gathering tools 3) Teaching, co-teaching, or exhibiting on behalf of the NN/LM 4) Publishing in any of the NN/LM's communication conduits regarding their participation with the NN/LM or NLM. Anytime Members participate in NNLM infrastructure, outreach programs, working groups, and assessment of NN/LM and/or NLM services should be reported. EXHIBITING BACKGROUND: Network members will be enlisted to assist with exhibits. Each member will be certified, which includes basic exhibit training and training on NLM resources being promoted at event. Members performance will be evaluated at state and local exhibits before being asked to exhibit at national exhibits. EDUCATION: Network member is chosen for qualifications and liaison's confidence in member's ability to present content and represent RML WORKGROUP, TEACHING/CO-TEACHING, EXHIBITOR BACKGROUND, COMMUNICATION CONTRIBUTORS: Example meanings of beneficial: Were they able to gain AHIP points or use their involvement to further their professional portfolio; did they feel their experience utilized their time respectfully and efficiently, etc. Each MCRML staff are responsible for gathering information for indicator: "75% of individuals from Network member Institutions indicate they had a beneficial experience..."</p>	
<b>Indicator:</b> [Communication] 75% of individuals from Network member Institutions indicate they had a beneficial experience contributing to NN/LM MCR communication conduits	

**Indicator:** [Education] 75% of individuals from Network member institutions indicate they had a beneficial experience and are satisfied with teaching or co-teaching as a representative of the NN/LM MCR

**Indicator:** [Exhibit] NN/LM MCR Liaisons from each state will certify at least one Network member as a certified exhibit staff

**Indicator:** [Workgroup] 75% of workgroup members from Network member institutions indicate they had a beneficial experience

**Indicator:** [Workgroup] Work group produces a product or program that is used by the MCR

**Goal:** The NN/LM MCR, in cooperation with the other NN/LM regions, will develop an inter regional emergency preparedness plan to be used in conjunction with the NLM National Emergency Preparedness Plan

**Outcome:** A National and Regional Emergency Preparedness plan will be in place to provide guidance for the NN/LM MCR in case of emergency

**LM\_Activity:** Emergency Preparedness: Implement components of the NN/LM MCR and NN/LM MCR NER emergency preparedness plan

**Background:** Yr 4: Plan and run tests of the NN/LM MCR and NN/LM MCR and NER's emergency preparedness plan.

**Indicator:** The NN/LM MCR successfully transfers communication conduits from MCR to NER

**Indicator:** The NN/LM MCR successfully transfers communication conduits within MCR from affected location[s] to non-affected location[s] within 3 hours

**RML Goal:** Develop tools and conduct evaluation activities to understand how the products and services of the NN/LM and NLM contribute to improved access to health information by health professionals, community organizations, network members and the public

**RML Goal:** Develop, promote, and improve electronic access to health information by Network members, health professionals, and organizations providing health information to the public

**Goal:** Document delivery provides health professionals including unaffiliated health professionals throughout the region with efficient, rapid access to health sciences information resources

**Outcome:** Overall document delivery practices for the region meet MCRML standards

**LM\_Activity:** Membership: Identify and work with Network members that are not meeting MCMRL minimum requirements for Membership to develop a plan that will improve their status

**Background:** Yrs 5: State liaisons are expected to work with Network members in their states in bettering their performance in the area of maintaining a 75% or better fill rate and keeping a current, lendable, collection of biomedical journals of 25 titles or greater. The Network Liaison will alert State Liaisons of the Network members in their states that need to be contacted and a plan for rehabilitation created.

**Indicator:** Fewer than 10% of NN/LM MCR Network members appear on NN/LM MCR performance reports as poor performing Network members

**Goal:** Support programs to improve the transfer of health care and biomedical information within Network members institutions and through their participation in the Network

**Outcome:** Programs are designed and carried out that meet the identified needs of health sciences libraries

**LM\_Activity:** Promote Resource Sharing, Document Delivery Services, and e-Resource licensing skills to Network members

**Background:** Yrs 4-5: State Liaisons identify Network Members who are eligible and don't use resource sharing, document delivery services and/or eResource licensing skills and will promote the benefits and encourage use. The services to focus on are Loansome Doc, Reference Continuity Services Network, EFTS, and LINKOUT.

**Indicator:** There will be five new EFTS users in the region

**Indicator:** [LINKOUT] 5% annual increase in Network members becoming LINKOUT libraries.

**Indicator:** [Loansome Doc] 5% annual increase in the number of unaffiliated health professionals registering to use Loansome Doc services

**Indicator:** [Ref Contin Serv] 6 libraries participate in the Reference Continuity Service Partnership project

**RML Goal:** Promote awareness of, access to, and use of biomedical information resources for health professionals and the public, with a particular emphasis on contributing to the Healthy People 2010 goal of eliminating health disparities
