
You can use the following text to describe MedlinePlus:

MedlinePlus directs you to information to help answer health questions. MedlinePlus brings together authoritative information from NLM, the National Institutes of Health (NIH), and other government agencies and health-related organizations. MedlinePlus also contains extensive information about drugs and supplements, an illustrated medical encyclopedia, interactive tutorials, the latest health news, and surgery videos.

You may use the Share button to link to that page in your individual social networks.

The instructions below describe how to embed the widgets and buttons on your own Web site. You can use the following buttons to link to the MedlinePlus on your own Web site. 
MedlinePlus Search Box

- Display the search results in their own window (not in a frame).

- Link the word MedlinePlus to the MedlinePlus homepage.

Search Cloud Widget



The search cloud widget displays the most frequently searched terms on MedlinePlus. This widget is usually updated each weekday, and it is a smaller version of the full-sized MedlinePlus search cloud. Widgets are small applications that allow you to access MedlinePlus content directly from your own websites. You can embed MedlinePlus widgets in blogs, personalized homepages, and other websites. Once you embed the widget on your site, MedlinePlus takes care of the technical maintenance and updates the content automatically.
