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## **Executive Summary**

### **Budget**

NLM sent questions regarding Option Year 1 in early March. SE/A responded to those and resubmitted with requested changes and appropriate amendments. SE/A requested extension of Base Year contracts for four >\$15,000 projects. (All but one of those projects did finish by April 30, 2011, but we had anticipated that all four would need the extension.) We submitted an extended budget at the request of NLM that brought our final Option Year 1 awards budget up to the same level of funding as the Base Year.

### **Funding/Awards**

With NLM's early approval of RFA/RFPs, SE/A advertised its Option Year 1 awards beginning in February with an application deadline in mid-March. With this early start, SE/A was able to make decisions about funding prior to the start of the new fiscal year in May. Consequently, we were able to begin preparing the MOUs and subcontracts for 33 projects. This number does not include projects we will fund with the extended budget; those additional projects will be determined in June 2012. Additionally, since these projects do not begin until May 1, 2011, they will not appear in this report as new projects, but in the first quarterly report of Option Year 1.

### **Personnel**

With the hiring of Andrew Youngkin in the 3rd quarter, SE/A is fully staffed.

## **Network Infrastructure**

### **Regional Advisory Committee (RAC) activities**

### Update of ongoing major projects (funded at >= \$15,000)

Outreach Award - PIA - Health Literacy - Computer Literacy - Health Information Access Trainin

During this quarter PIA conducted 37 hands-on computer workshops by taking PIA'S own laptop computers and using a mobile wireless internet modem to create a wireless internet environment to local/programs. The workshops primarily focused on health literacy/computer literacy and web navigation and finding health information on the internet. Ten PowerPoint health presentations on various health topics at some locations were also completed.

Outreach Award - University of Alabama - Video-- & NLM-- Enhanced User Interfaces: An Information Sh

This project has received full-board medical IRB approval, has three hired students working in different capacities, and is in the final stages of prototyping the system/digital library for use by the rural clinic, which includes completion of the video processing programs and the web/client side. An onsite session has been scheduled to train the rural clinicians about video collection and contribution, and one of the participating researchers ran a series of preliminary interviews on site and has already presented a poster on that data. An article for JMLA has been drafted and project staff have met with others regarding future grant proposals to be submitted to NIH for expanding the current project.

CTSA Award - University of Florida - Developing an infrastructure for information support

for clinic

Awardees have made substantial progress towards completing their project. Most of the interviews and data collection have been completed, and their data analysis should be completed by the extended deadline. They attended and presented their preliminary results at MLA 2012 in Seattle, WA. They will complete their project in time and their results will have a major impact on their constituents in the CTSI program at the University of Florida.

Outreach Award - Military Partners & Families Coalition: Providing Health and Mental-Health Informat

Military Partners and Families Coalition (MPFC) launched, beginning in February 2012, a monthly virtual safe-space discussion group for target population, in collaboration with the Military Acceptance Project (MAP) from University of Southern California School of Social Work. They also released and promoted the MPFC Community Study Survey, the first of its kind nationwide survey to assess the health and mental health needs of LGB Servicemember families. MPFC hosted three (February, March, April) virtual safe space discussions in collaboration with the Military Acceptance Project and will continue to host these monthly virtual events and to increase awareness of health and mental health issues and resources relevant to the target population through bi-monthly e-blasts and resources on the web.
